Policies:

- Students must commit to yearlong courses regardless of teacher preference, course preference, or grading marks earned.

Process:

- 1) Transcript review – January review with students through English class
- 2) Course selection presentations – February informational presentations through SS/SCI classes
- 3) Course Selection Google Form – Complete via Google Classroom/RMHS Website
- 4) 1:1 counselor conference – February appointment with students through SS/PE classes
- 5) Add/Drop Week – May Google Form to make any changes to selection requests

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
