D., Principal</p>	<p>Vote to approve additional proposals..</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• in spring we (SSC) votes to spend money according to budget proposal document</li> <li>• Title 1- majority is paid for staffing for math intervention and paraprofessional support (80% of 2 bilingual), ELD 4 sections, Edgenuity Zero period, EBSCO program to do research in library, AVID conference,, online journalism license, Math Intervention (IM II) teacher, AP exam- total106,500</li> <li>• LCAP- more flexible- field trips, other supplies, (Science and others), CABE, Talking Points (?), TTECHS, RACE requested 2,000 for equipments</li> <li>• EDIT COMPUTERS- Computer money allocated last year in SSC was not used because order did not arrive by June 30 deadline (budget), so they couldn't be paid from last year's budget- Fiscal approved using AP exam fees money (25,000) and Talking Points (8,000) money, and use t to pay for these.</li> <li>• Extra 38,000 we just received from the district was used to replace that money. Almost exact amount was required</li> <li>• Dominic Lopez asked for clarification as to the difference in funds between TTECHS and RACE- Dr. Haga explained these were based on proposals from staff that were already approved by 2021-22 SSC.</li> </ul>
